



### Day by Day Itinerary

**Day 1 & 2** - Flight from Minneapolis to Kilimanjaro  
Dinner and overnight at Moshi Mountain Inn

**Day 3** - Rest and prepare by putting together our climbing materials. An early evening pre-climb to acclimatize and a pre-briefing on the trek before the start of the climb the next day.



**Day 4** - Transfer from our hotel to the Kilimanjaro National Park Gate at Machame. From here we trek through the lush forest to Machame Hut (10,000ft).

Dinner and overnight at the camp.

**Day 5** - Breakfast at our camp. Leaving the forest, the path follows a steep ridge, passing through heather and open moorlands, and crossing a large gorge to reach Shira Hut (12,500ft/3800m).

Dinner and overnight at Shira Hut



**Day 6** - This morning turn eastwards and continue ascending through the dry landscape before dropping again to reach Barranco Hut (13,000ft/3900m).

Dinner and overnight at Barranco Hut/Camp.

**Day 7** - Cross the floor of the Great Barranco Valley, up the Barranco Wall to the Karanga river - the last water point on this route to Karanga camp at 4000m taking 4 to 5 hours. Overnight at Karanga Camp.

**Day 8** - A steep climb over rocky slabs to Barafu Campsite at 15500ft/ 4600m. Overnight Barafu camp.



**Day 9** - A long day and an early start to reach the crater rim at Stella Point in time for sunrise. Then to Uhuru Peak (19,340ft/5896m) - the highest point in Africa. Afterwards descend to Mweka Hut (10,300ft/3100m).

Dinner and overnight at the camp.



**Day 10** - Descend to the park gate, from where we are transferred back to our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at the Hotel



**Day 11** - Breakfast at Mountain Inn. Pick up and proceed on safari to Ngorongoro Conservation Area arriving in time for lunch at Lemala Ngorongoro.

After lunch, drive to Empakai crater for walking.

Early this evening drive back to Lemala Ngorongoro for dinner and overnight

**Day 12** - After breakfast, full day tour of Ngorongoro crater. Picnic lunch on the way. Here you can see a spectacular concentration of wildlife, including the big five. Drive across the dense forest and near the soda lake and enjoy viewing a variety of bird life. Ascend to the lodge from the 2000ft. deep crater for our private sunset cocktail.

Dinner and overnight at Lemala Ngorongoro camp.



**Day 13** - After breakfast, Drive to Mto wa Mbu for cultural tour and continue to Arusha for lunch.

After lunch we will be transferred to Kilimanjaro Airport for onward flight home.

**The Climb Package includes:**

- Ground transfers with pick-up & drop-off as per the itinerary.
- Kilimanjaro park entry, mountain guide and porters fees.
- Full accommodation in huts/camps on the mountain.
- 3 nights half board Accommodation at mountain Inn in Moshi.

**The package does not include:**

Climbing equipment & sleeping bags, warm clothing, drinks, immunizations, gratuities, Visa fees, personal & travel insurance; laundry, telecommunications costs; and all other personal expenses

**NOTE:** It is advisable for climbers to bring your own sleeping bags and warm clothing including walking shoes and boots. The following additional climbing gear is recommended: rack sack, rain jacket, gloves, balaclava, sunglasses, and scarf.

**The Safari Tour includes:**

- All airport transfers as per the itinerary
- All game viewing drives using a shared 4x4 safari vehicle with a pop-up roof as per the itinerary
- All park entry fees
- Visit to Mto wa Mbu
- Ngorongoro safari walk AND Sunset cocktail
